## FRESHMEN COURSE REGISTRATION

### 4-year Plan

To access the 4-year plan, log in to PAC and click on the 4-year Plan tab. The 4-year plan should have the following:

- \_\_\_\_ 4 English credits
- \_\_\_\_ 4 Math credits
- \_\_\_\_ 4 Science credits
- \_\_\_\_ 4 Social Studies credits
- \_\_\_\_ 5.5 elective credits
- \_\_\_\_ 2 credits of foreign language
- \_\_\_\_ 1 credit of PE (or athletics)
- \_\_\_\_ 0.5 credit of Health
- \_\_\_\_ 1 credit of fine art

### Instructions for Course Registration:

- Course selections for 2019-20 will be downloaded from the student's four year plan.  
**Courses listed in Year 1 will be the student's courses for next year.**
- Students and parents can access the student four year plan through SAC (Student Access Center) and PAC (Parent Access Center), respectively.
- Students should select a total of 7 credits (before alternates).
- Teachers have made course advisements. The advisements are reflected on the student's four year plan.  
**Students and parents should carefully consider the advisement before making a final course selection.**
- Advanced courses will require an Advanced Course Agreement form. These forms will be sent electronically at the close of course registration. Agreements not signed will result in student removal from the advanced course.
- Some courses may not be available for student selection. Reasons for this may be:
  - The courses require a tryout. After tryouts, the sponsor will provide a list of approved students to the counselors. (i.e., Cheerleading, Drill Team, Color Guard.)
  - The course requires a prerequisite that the student has not completed.
  - The student is not in the appropriate grade for the course.
  - The course is listed elsewhere in the student's four year plan. (Students will need to edit the plan and move the course.)
- **Students must list 3 credits of alternates.** Order the courses in priority by clicking on the order button by the drop down menu.

- Four year plans and course registration will close on February 10<sup>th</sup>. However, course request changes will be accepted until April 26<sup>th</sup>. For any course request changes after the closing of registration, parents will need to email the appropriate counselor below.
